Sermon Overview: God knows and loves you beyond what you can understand or maybe believe; it is supernatural love/the God kind of love. It is unconditional, in relentless pursuit of you, never abandoning or giving up on you, always waiting for and welcoming you when you return to Him.

Sermon Series Questions:

- 1. How does God love me well?
- 2. Have I received God's love?
- 3. How do I walk out God's love in my life?

Sermon Specific Questions:

- 1. What life experiences prevent me from receiving the full expression of God's love?
- 2. What circumstances have given me glimpses of God's love for me and others?
- 3. How can I better share God's Love with everyone around me?

Dig Deeper:

1. Study, meditate, pray into, and let God minister to you through Psalm 139:1-4.

2. Find one young person and tell them how much God loves them (even though they may not want to hear it.) You are planting seeds or watering them that will grow into understanding.

3. Be mindful of when things happen that may cause you to doubt God's love and goodness, know that you are loved by God no matter what.
